We recently launched our Innovation Fund, an initiative that we hope will enable and encourage front-line people to translate their great ideas into service for the benefit of patients. We have already approved 18 applications from our scientists for this seed funding.

In terms of infrastructure investment, in April we announced an £11m enterprise laboratory information management system (LIMS) programme that will start to deliver benefits during 2014.

This will further improve the quality of patient care through the streamlined tracking and routing of specimens, the electronic communication of test results, and the verification of key patient demographics to ensure the right test is done on the right patient.

Change is being driven by clinical and scientific innovations arising from new molecular test and gene sequencing. We are investing in both people and hardware to bring these innovations into service for the benefit of our NHS customers and patients."
